Focused on the well known troubadour theme “love from afar”, this programme is a journey through love feelings related to absence -due to war, crusade, tournament or paternal interdictions...). This leads to a non-conventional way through styles and different times, through court and village music, an immersion into the large world of Song, in company with its first servants -the Troubadours (Bernart de Ventadorn, Jauffré Rudel, Raimbaut de Vacqueiras, Gaucelm Faidit), the Trouvères (Guiot de Dijon, Adam de la Halle, Lescurel...) and the Galician poet Martim Codax- and with its eternal servants the traditional Spanish, Occitan and Sephardic singing poets...
